Subject: Observance of 10th Ayurveda Day-Ayurveda for People and Planet-reg.

## आदरणीय महोदया/महोदय,

As you are aware, Government of India, through a notification published in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary, Part I) dated 1st June, 2017 resolved to celebrate Ayurveda Day annually on the occasion of Dhanwantari Jayanti (Dhanteras). This initiative aims to promote, propagate, and popularize Ayurveda as a system of holistic health and wellness.

Since Dhanteras is celebrated according to the Hindu calendar (in the month of Kartik), its date generally varies between mid-October and mid-November often coinciding with Diwali festivities. This variability has affected the visibility and participation in Ayurveda Day activities. To address these challenges and to facilitate global observance on a uniform date, it has been decided to celebrate Ayurveda Day on 23rd September from this year onwards. This change has been notified on 27.03.2025. Notably, 23rd September marks the autumnal equinox, when day and night are nearly equal-symbolizing balance in nature, which aligns closely with Ayurveda philosophy that emphasizes harmony between the mind and body.

This year marks the **10th Anniversary** of Ayurveda Day since its inception in 2016. The theme for the 10th Ayurveda Day is "Ayurveda for People and Planet," highlighting Ayurveda's role in promoting individual well-being alongside ecological balance and sustainability.

The All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), Goa has been designated as the nodal unit for celebration of 10th Ayurveda Day. Various activities are planned to be conducted across India and internationally.
