**About the College:**

Chandrakona Vidyasagar Mahavidyalaya, affiliated to Vidyasagar University, made its humble beginning on 16th December 1985 and has crossed 39 glorious years in the pursuit of excellence, and has made remarkable strides, in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It is a UGC approved institution and gained recognition under the UGC Act of 1956 U/S 2(f) & 12 (B) in 1994.

Lt. Shri. Satya Gopal Mukhopadhyay on behalf of Kalyanshree Trust, Lt. Shri. Ramdas Ramanujan on behalf of Chandrakona Municipality, Lt. Shri. Anukul Chandra Rai and Shri Madhusudhan Chakravorty donated 6 land whereas the lumpsum donation by Smt. Kali Bala Dasi and the generous monetary help of all classes of people of Chandrakona I and II Block as well as a small section of people's donations from Keshpur and Garhbeta Block helped in the construction of the college building. Under the aegis of the chief patrons that is the then, Honourable M.P. and M.L.A., and the owners of the cold storages of the nearby areas; the long standing demand for a college in Chandrakona Town finally was realised. Late Prabhash Fodikar, the then M.I.C. of Information and Culture, Govt. of West Bengal inaugurated the college in 1985.

In the initial days the college offered six General Degree courses namely in Bengali, English, History, Economics, Political Science, Philosophy and operated with a humble staff of six lecturers and twelve nonteaching staff under the able guidance of the Principal Lt. Shri. Biman Mahato. Since its inception, the college has carved out a niche in the academic frame of the district. The college at present offers thirteen Honours and fifteen General UG courses in Arts and Science streams and hopes to offer more UG courses and open PG departments in future.

## ANNUAL REPORT of the year 2023-24:

- Chandrakona Vidyasagar Mahavidyalaya has crossed 39 glorious years in the pursuit of excellence, and has made remarkable strides, in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- The College offers 15-Undergraduate, and 11 Value-Added Courses.
  - 2358 students are the beneficiaries of these programmes and among which 847 number of seats earmarked for reserved category.
- The college has a Study Centre of Netaji Subhas Open University in its premises which is recognized by the UGC Distance Education Bureau that offers both UG and PG courses and promotes distance learning.
  - 300 students are the beneficiaries of these programmes
- **Seventy five (75)** Teaching, Administrative and Support staff are involved in the smooth functioning of the College.

It is my proud privilege, to initiate the presentation of our College Annual Report of the year 2023-24, highlighting some of the key milestones achieved over the past year:

## HIGHLIGHTS of the year 2023-2024:

- Secured **B<sup>+</sup>** grade with CGPA of 2.56 in the First Cycle of NAAC Accreditation.
- College was listed in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF-2023) conducted by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India.
- Our college is primarily selected as Computer based Test Centre (CBT) under NTA (National Testing Agency)
- Our college has established a skill development centre called the IRABOTI SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE. By which, we are offering three courses in collaboration with the Government of West Bengal: Garment Manufacturing, a Beautician Course, DTP Training, and a Certificate Course in Spoken English and Spoken Sanskrit.
- Established an E-learning centre
- Enabled IT Infrastructure in Library
- Implemented Solar Panel at college campus and started Rainwater harvesting
- Started Student Health Scheme
- Constructed an Open-Air Theatre (Sanskritik Mandap) and a Seminar Hall
- An Audio-visual lecture recording studio in the college premises was built up to encourage faculty participation in the creation of MOOCs and engagement with SWAYAM.
- Introduced food festival for the first time on college campus to boost local art and craft



- All registered students at our college have ABC id. Creation of Digi locker identity available for the students to ensure the benefit of the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC).
- Cultural Evolution Society Transformation Fund grant of 3800 Euros was sanctioned to Chandrakona Vidyasagar Mahavidyalaya in 2023.
- Enhanced the number of MOU to provide better education to our students.
- Upgraded the function of Career Counselling cum Placement Cell
- This year, we have a total of 18 students who were placed, and 93 students were progressed.
- ONE teaching staff was retired from service this year.
